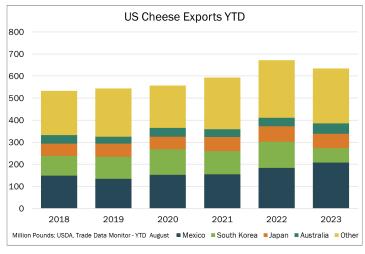
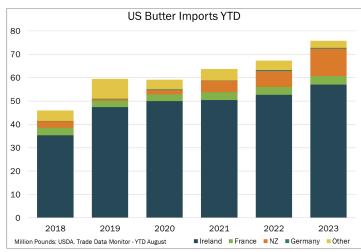
TRADE TRENDS



October 5, 2023

- Better cheese export activity was the talk of the market this summer. Exports were, in fact, a little perkier in August, topping July levels, but the total for the month still trailed last year's pace. Shipments totaled 82 million pounds, up 1% from July but still down 3% from 2022. Mexico remains a key growth center for US cheese exporters, with sales reaching 30 million pounds in August, up 14% versus last year. Sales into Japan and Australia also picked up, with volume reaching 10 million pounds (+37% year-over-year) and 5 million pounds (+87% year-over-year), respectively. US shipments into South Korea, however, remain soft, with 8 million pounds exported to the region, a 45% reduction from the year prior and -8% from July. Year-to-date through August, total US cheese exports grossed 635 million pounds, 6% behind 2022. Cheese imports, on the other hand, picked up significantly, reaching 41 million pounds. That was up 5% from last year and the largest inbound August cheese volume going back to at least 1996.
- NDM/SMP exports picked back up in August, with 151 million pounds moving internationally, a 4% gain from 2022. A bump up in sales to Mexico helped drive the uptick, with volume reaching 74 million pounds, up 6% on the year. Volume into Southeast Asia also jumped, totaling 51 million pounds, a 17% increase from the year before. Stronger August exports helped bring year-to-date volumes to 1.231 million pounds, unchanged from 2022.
- Butter exports continue to fall short of prior-year levels, with August shipments totaling 5 million pounds, on par with the month before but down 63% from 2022. Sales into Canada were off 31% from August 2022 levels, though exports to the region accounted for 68% of US shipments during the month. Butter imports held up in August, with 9 million pounds crossing into the US, unchanged from the year before.
- August whey exports remained sluggish, with 31 million pounds shipped, down 38% year-over-year.
 Volume into China remained under pressure, with shipments falling 45% from August 2022.

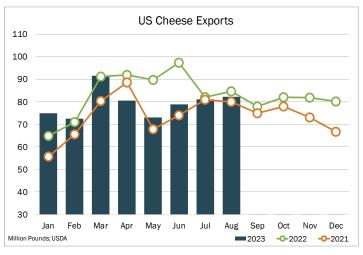


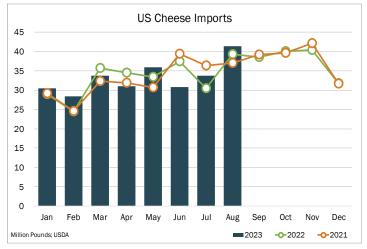


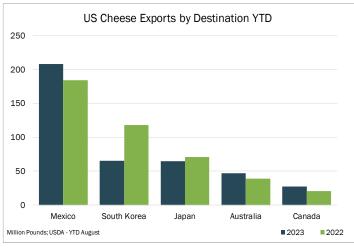


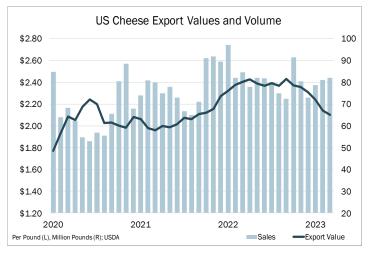

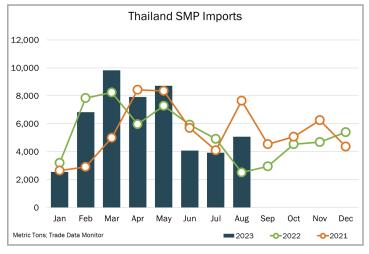
Key Takeaways

- European SMP exports dropped dramatically between June and July, with 67,099 metric tons shipped, down 13,971 metric tons (-17%) from the month before. Much of the month-to-month decline was driven by a 6.272-metric-ton slide in volume to Algeria. Even with the monthly decrease, however, shipments outpaced prior year levels by 10%, taking year-to-date volumes through July up 25% year-over-year.
- China milk powder imports remain soft, driven by weakness in WMP volume. WMP imports year-to-date through August totaled 350,713 metric tons, a 38% drop from 2022. Inbound SMP volume, meanwhile, ticked up to 262,943 metric tons, 13% higher. For the month of August, China's total milk powder imports tallied 49,895 metric tons, down 20% from the year before.
- Thailand's SMP imports pushed higher in August, with 5,074 metric tons brought in, doubling July 2022 volumes. Year-to-date imports reached 48,894 metric tons, a 7% gain from the year prior.







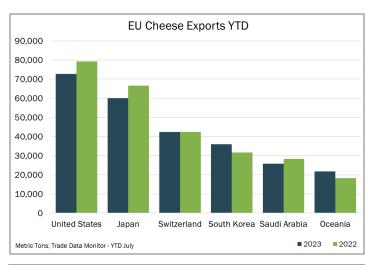


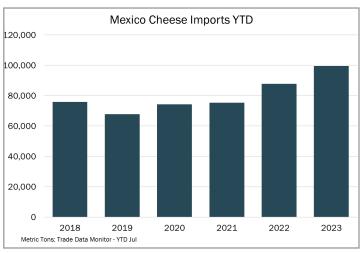


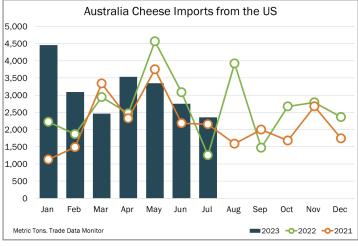

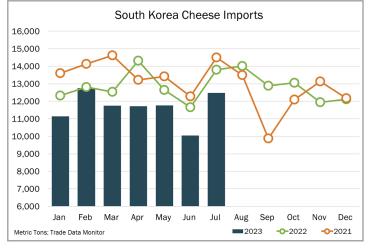
Key Takeaways

- Inbound volume into Mexico through July increased steadily over the year before. A total of 99,450 metric tons of cheese moved into the country, a 13% gain. Much of that volume came out of the US, with imports totaling 60,904 metric tons, down 10% from the year before. Mexico cheese imports in July alone totaled 14,133 metric tons, an 8% hike from 2022.
- Cheese exports out of Europe held firm in July, with 79,598 metric tons shipped, up 3% year-over-year. Sales into Chile were strong, with 2,324 metric tons exported to the region, up from 690 metric tons (+237%) in 2022. Volume into China also perked up to 2,843 metric tons, a 27% gain from 2022. Year-to-date through July, European cheese exports were running ahead of the prior year by nearly 2%.
- Australia cheese imports from the US remained choppy into July, with 2,358 metric tons landing. That
 was down 14% from June levels but up 87% from July 2022. Inbound volume from the US year-to-date
 through July outpaced prior year levels by 20% and accounted for 32% of cheese imports.

Key Takeaways

- New Zealand butter and AMF exports to the US pushed higher year-to-date through August, with a
 combined total of 17,664 metric tons shipped, up 203% year-over-year. Shipments of butter rose to
 9,012 metric tons, a 118% gain from August 2022, marking the largest year-to-date volume since at
 least 2007. AMF volume reached 8,652 metric tons, notching a five-fold increase year-over-year and
 hitting the largest outbound volume to the US since 2020.
- Canada remains a big buyer of butter. Imports year-to-date through July pushed up to 18,853 metric tons, a 13% bump from 2022 levels. While monthly volumes from the US eased 4% year-over-year, the US remains the largest supplier of butter into Canada, accounting for 62% share, or 11,721 metric tons to date. New Zealand is the second-largest supply base, with 37% market share and year-to-date shipments of 6,948 metric tons, up 58% from year-to-date July 2022.
- China whey imports slipped some in August, with 49,706 metric tons imported, down 21% from 2022.
