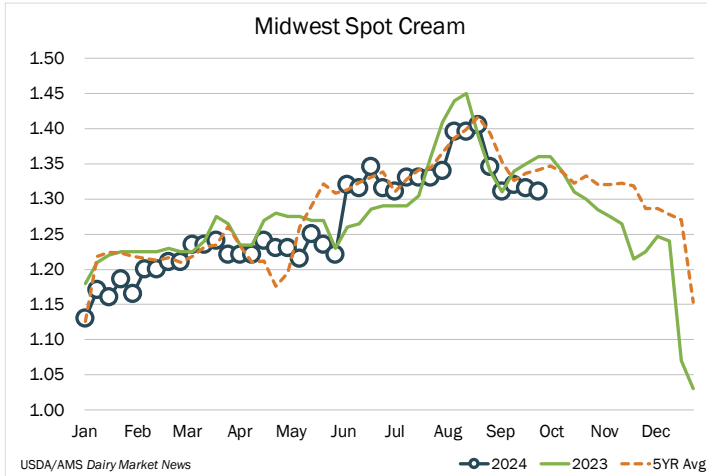


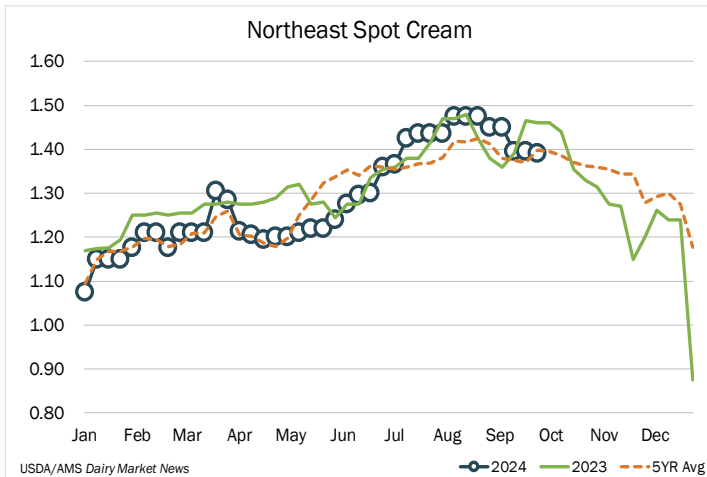

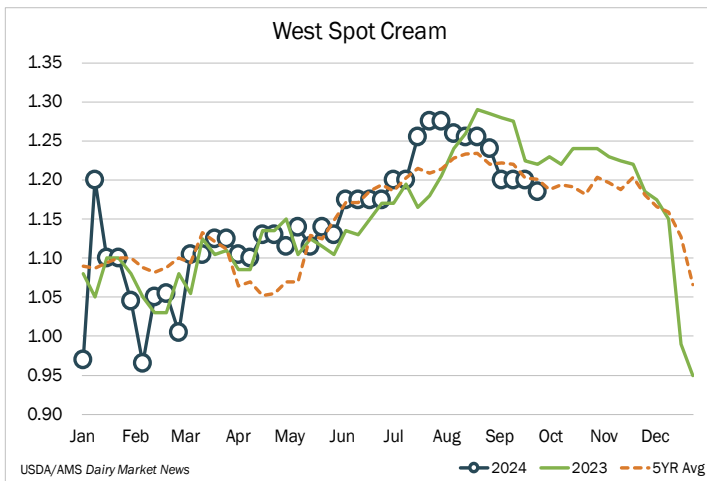
## Midwest

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## Here is what USDA/AMS had to say:

**Midwest:** Cream availability is less variant, as it is and has been available throughout most of the month of September. Butter makers reported turning away spot cream offers due to running full. They have also said next week's cream story is similar to this week's, as they have already locked in loads at multiples at/around 1.20.

**Northeast:** Cream availability is noted to be strong. Cream is available for spot purchasers. The All-Class cream multiples range contracted this week.

**West:** Class II demand is mixed. Cream is widely available throughout the region. Stakeholders note cream demand as lighter. Cream multiples moved lower on the top end of both ranges.
