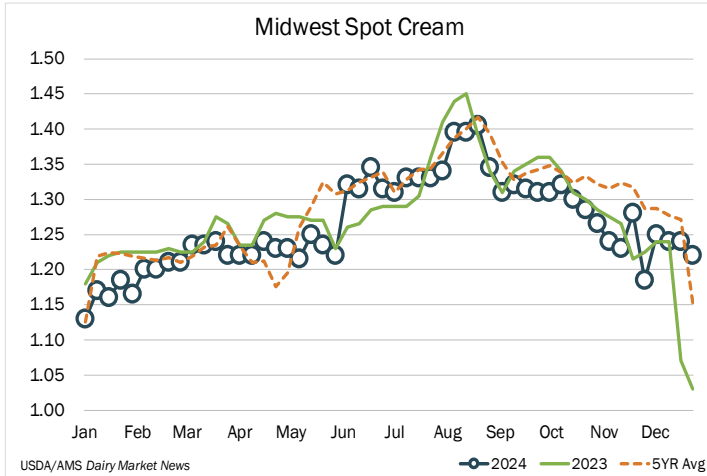
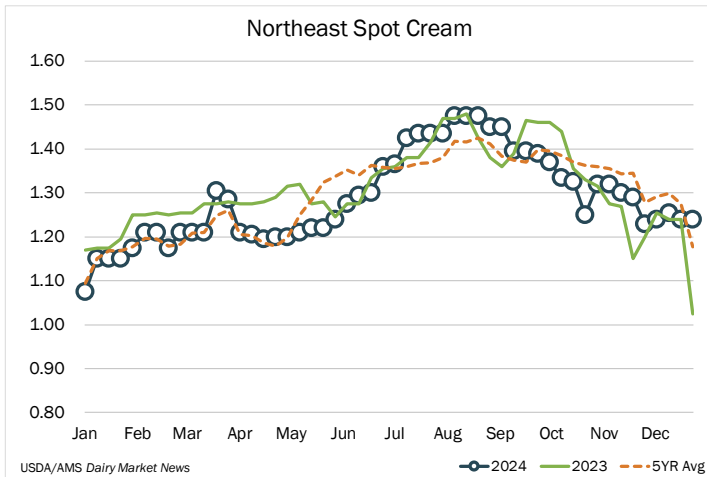

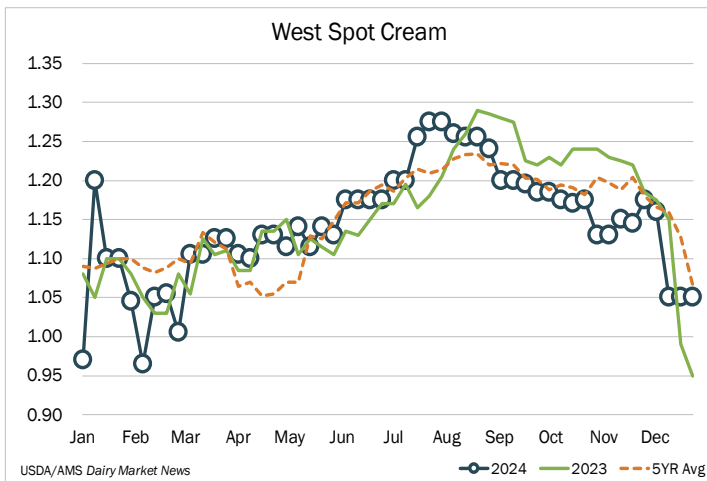

## Here is what USDA/AMS had to say:

**Midwest:** Cream market expectations differ from fluid milk. Cream end users, particularly butter plant managers, expect plentiful volumes of cream in the near term. Butter makers say they are looking ahead to the spring holiday push during these final weeks of 2024.

**Northeast:** Cream remains abundant in the East. Demand from Class II and Class IV is steady. Class II production picked up slightly in recent weeks, and surplus cream found its way into churns.

**West:** Cream loads are widely available to start the end of year holiday stretch. Among industry participants, trading activity is quiet. Cream multiples are unchanged this week.
